Lower School Sports Day

Our annual Sports Day is on **Monday 26th June at 2pm**. We hope to see as many of you there as possible – family members are also welcome. As with all Sports Days we are dependent upon the weather, so keep your fingers crossed for sunshine!

Your children will be led down to the fields by their class teacher, and will participate in a range of events including: the Long Jump, Sprints, a Hoop Race, Bean Bag Race, Egg & Spoon Race, Tennis Ball/Javelin Throw (depending on age), 'Dress-up' Relay and a Running Relay.

You should arrive at 2 o'clock and walk down the side of Upper School towards the field.

You are welcome to move around the activities to watch your children compete, but please be mindful of small children and the sporting activities going on around you!

This is a House Competition so pupils will earn points for their House; the winners being the team with most points. There will be awards at our usual end of term ceremony for the Best Sportsman and Sportswoman in each class. This is judged by Mr Nicholls and his team as 'those who have the best sporting attitude' rather than ability alone.

In order for the day to run smoothly please make sure:

- Pupils come to school wearing their PE kits (shorts and t-shirt). As the weather is so unpredictable it is a good idea for the children to bring, or wear, their school tracksuit to put on when not competing.
- Remember to send the children in prepared for all possible weather conditions and apply sun cream before school. Pupils may bring their sun hats just in case the sun is shining!
- Pupils wear their black pumps or trainers of their choice.
- Pupils have labelled water bottles with them.

You are welcome to record the event with cameras or videos, but as usual I would remind you that unless you have parental consent, images that include other children should not be shared on social media.
